¹ Licensed Architects may practise architecture only if they have completed the following:

- Provided a certificate of insurance as a Sole Proprietor;
- Confirmed that they practise exclusively on behalf of a holder of a Corporate Permit; or
- Confirmed that they practise exclusively on behalf of a Municipal, Provincial, or Federal Government Department.

²Licenses and Business Registrations/Corporate Permits must be maintained for a minimum of one year following completion of all projects.

³ The fee for Retired Architect is waived for an individual with a membership of 40 years or more with the NSAA.

⁴ Nova Scotia Law requires that all businesses operating in Nova Scotia register with the Registry of Joint Stock Companies, except 1) New Brunswick (NB) corporations and NB partnerships/business names registered in NB; 2) Individuals or partners using only their personal names, without a description element or attachment such as "and Associates"; or 3) Partnerships whose sole purpose is farming or fishing. Those businesses not registered with the Nova Scotia of Registry of Joint Stock Companies are not charged a business registration fee.

⁵ While registered with the NSAA, businesses registered with the Nova Scotia Registry of Joint Stock Companies must maintain current registration with the Registry. Failure to do so may impact the business' ability to practise architecture.
