- Provided a certificate of insurance as a Sole Proprietor;
- Confirmed they practise exclusively on behalf of a holder of a Corporate Permit; or
- Confirmed they practise exclusively on behalf of a Municipal, Provincial, or Federal Government Department

² Licenses and Business Registrations/Corporate Permits must be maintained for a minimum of one year following completion of all projects.

³ The fee for Retired Architects is waived for an individual with 40 years or more as a member of the NSAA

⁴ NS Law requires all businesses operating in Nova Scotia to register with the Registry of Joint Stock Companies except

- 1) New Brunswick corporations and NB partnerships/business names registered in New Brunswick
- 2) Individuals or partners using only their personal names without a description element or attachment such as "and Associates, or
- 3) Partnerships whose sole purpose is farming or fishing.

Those businesses not registered with the NS Registry of Joint Stocks are not charged a business registration fee.

⁵ While registered with the NSAA, businesses registered with the NS Registry of Joint Stock Companies must continue to be registered with the Registry. Failure to do so may impact the business' ability to practice architecture.
